# Manor Country Club

## Trial Membership Program

Trial Membership allows full Club privileges in a non-voting status. A limited number of this type of membership (20) will be available. Proposals for membership will be *accepted at any time between November 1, 2009 and July 1, 2010*.

### **The guidelines for this membership are as follows:**

- Covers the period of time that the Trial Member Applicant is approved by the Board of Governors and expires as of July 31, 2010.
- The membership fee at the time a Trial Member joins is locked in through July 31, 2010.
- Full member admission process and approval of Trial Members to include sponsorship and a credit check.
- Payment is required of a non-refundable deposit of \$1,000 to be credited against the Membership Fee provided that commitment to full membership is made by July 31, 2010. **(Trial Members are exempt from special assessments but will however, be responsible for the regular monthly fees and quarterly minimum spending throughout the Trial Membership period.)**
- The Trial Member will be required to sign an agreement that holds him/her accountable for any outstanding debt to the Club at the end of the Trial membership period.
- **The fee paid with the proposal for Trial membership is \$1,000 plus an application fee of \$125 for a total of \$1,125.**

### **How to apply:**

- The proposal for membership needs to be filled out and signed by the Proposed Trial Member.
- A check made out to Manor Country Club in the amount of \$1,125 needs to accompany the proposal for membership.
- The approval process begins upon the Club's receipt of the proposal for membership and a signed copy of the Trial Membership Agreement, which the Proposed Trial Member will receive once the Club has received their proposal for membership. The Admissions Committee will post the new Proposed Trial Member for ten (10) days and contact the Proposed Trial Member to set up an interview. Once the Proposed Trial Member has been interviewed, the posting period has expired and a credit check has been completed, the Admissions Committee will then present the Proposed Trial Member's proposal for membership to the Board of Governors for its approval. Upon approval by the Board, the Proposed Trial Member will receive official notice of his/her approval as a Trial Member of Manor Country Club.

### **Food and Beverage Minimum Spending:**

Each quarter the Trial Member must spend at least \$255 in food and beverage. If the Trial Member does not spend \$255 in a given quarter, he/she shall be billed the difference plus tax.
